

Gifted Identification

All public schools in Ohio identify gifted students per the Ohio Revised Code and the Operating Standards for Identifying and Serving Gifted Children. Reading Community School District identifies children in grades kindergarten through twelve, who may be gifted in one or more of the following areas: exceptionally high IQ; exceptionally high academic ability in math, science, reading, writing, and/or social studies; exceptional creative thinking ability; and/or exceptional artistic and musical talent.

The district ensures-as with all programs-equal opportunity for all children identified as gifted to receive any or all services offered by the district. Procedures are also in place for withdrawing students from gifted services and for resolving disputes with regard to identification and placement decisions.

Anyone wishing to refer a student may complete a Gifted Referral Form and return it to the building counselor.
