Superintendent Report

Mr. Enix provided an update on the following topics:

- 1. Inclement Weather Plan: With the current morning and afternoon sessions, a two-hour delay isn't practical. Treasurers Report

Ms. Colette Lewis presented the district's Five-Year Forecast for board review and will ask for approval at the November 18, 2020 board meeting. Even with \$1.8 million in cuts for the current school year, the district is expected to face expenses that outpace revenues as early as FY2021. Lewis recommended the district begin developing an operating levy strategy with the goal of being on the ballot no later than November 2021.
