

Parent Survey Results - June 2020




Survey Opened June 17-June 26, 2020 712 responses






Given what you know today about COVID-19, do you expect school buildings to be open for the first day of the school year?

- No. I do not expect buildings to be open with the start of the new school year.




Why do you expect that school buildings will not be open at the start of the school year?

- No. I will not be comfortable sending my child(ren) to school.




Why will you have no reservations about sending your child(ren) to school?

I believe the school can implement safety precautions to keep students safe


I believe the value of in-person schooling outweighs any potential risks

Select the health and safety measures that are most important to you that should be in place at the start of the school year.






Why will you not be comfortable sending your child(ren) to school?

The risk of COVID-19 at school will be too great


My child(ren) have underlying health issues that put him/her/them at a greater risk

Upon our return, we will follow the Ohio Department of Health guidelines on face coverings/masks. What is your stance on your child(ren) wearing a mask?




- I am in full support of my child wearing a mask to protect everyone in the builing.

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## **Parent Survey Results Reopening School**


Suppose the Ohio Department of Health and the Ohio Department of Education strictly limits the number of students that can be in a classroom at any given time - which would you prefer?

- I do not want my child(ren) in the school building if it has not been deemed safe for all students to be there at the same time.




