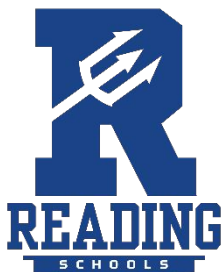
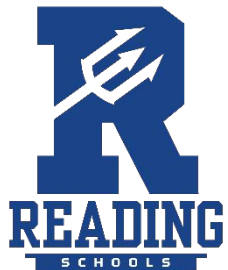

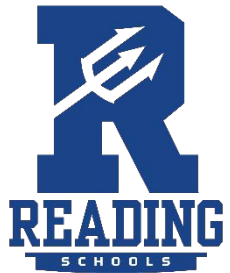

Central Property Cost Analysis

Review from 7/7/21

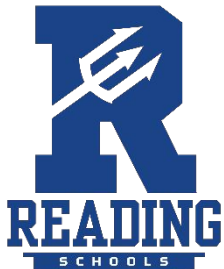
- **Security**
 - Fencing - approximately \$52,000 (4 ft vinyl)
 - ~~– Bollards/trees approximately \$100,000~~
 - ~~– Camera/video surveillance estimate - \$30,000 startup/installation~~
 - ~~• Equipment, site work, fiberoptics, service agreements, etc~~
 - ~~• Monthly service charge for internet connection (~\$100)~~
- **Repair (existing damage)**
 - Quote - \$2,578
- **Maintenance**
 - \$145 per mow
 - Lawn applications, aeration, and seeding - \$5,735 annually
- **Restroom Facility (portable)**
 - \$115/month + delivery, tax, fuel surcharge, and winter salt (1 unit)

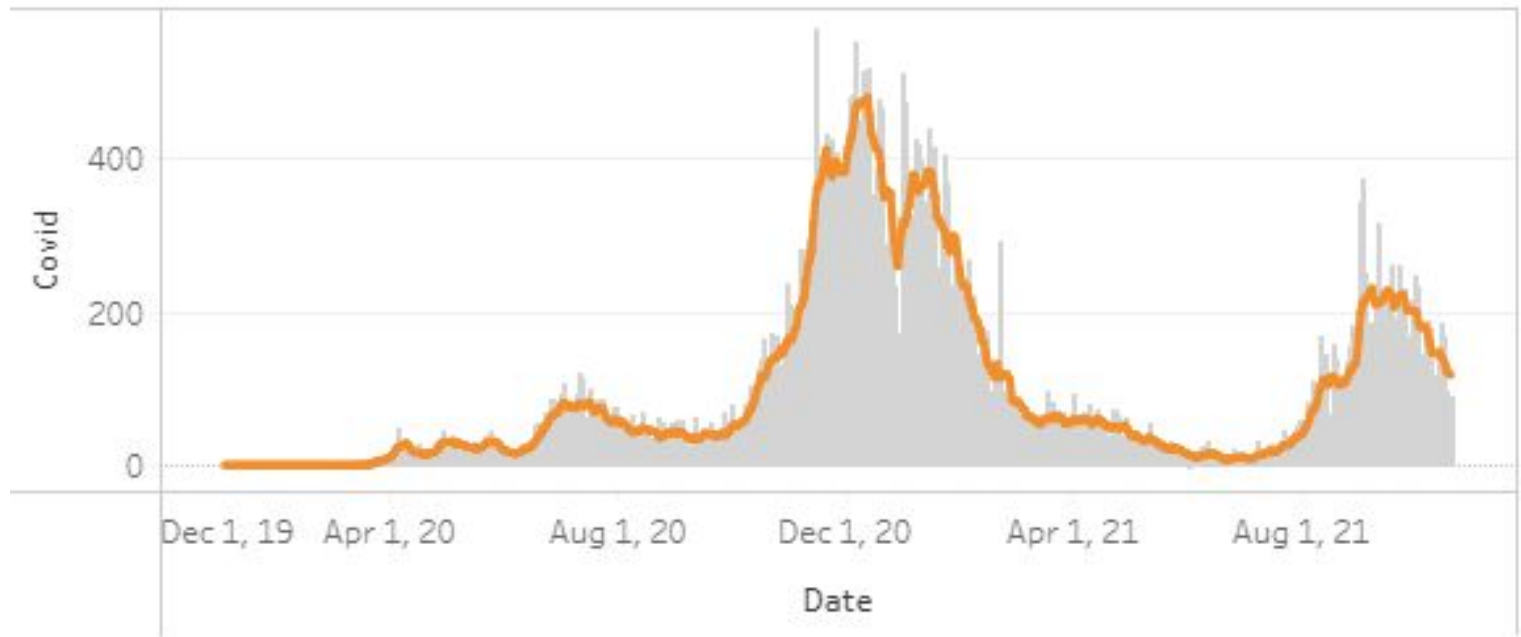

HCPH Daily Cases

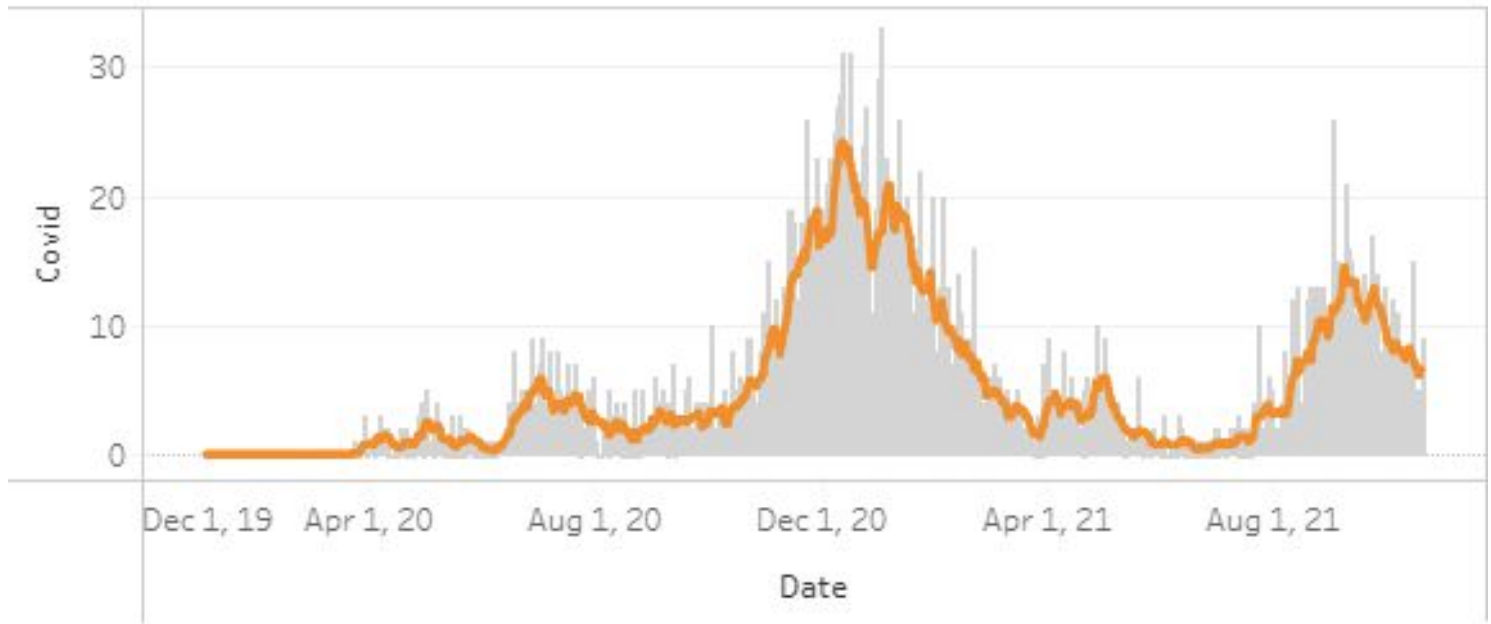
