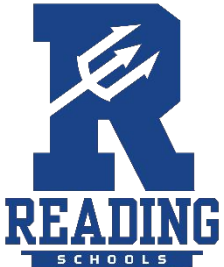

- Irrigation system winterized



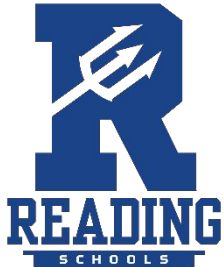
Buildings and Grounds

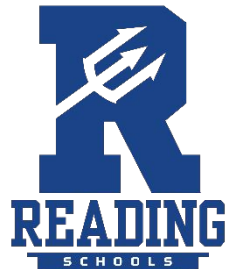

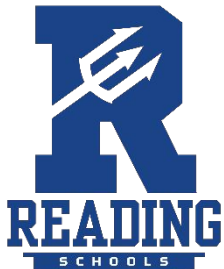

Summary of Benefits to Revision:

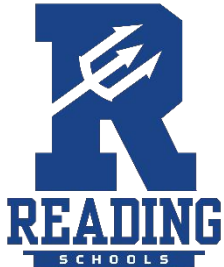
- New professional development dates - 12/3/21 and 1/14/22
- All staff able to participate in the important work of curriculum revision, alignment, and course of study development (Math)
- Sub shortage is a significant concern
 - Demonstrated during the first three months of school
 - Days and instances would create undue stress on district and staff to accommodate the coverage needs
- Financial savings - an estimated \$15,000-\$18,000 cost savings for substitutes/internal coverage
- Minor decrease in student hours reported - still well over ODE requirements
- Aligns with Strategic Plan objectives of Student Learning and Fiscal Responsibility



SB 1 - Substitute Qualifications

Summary:

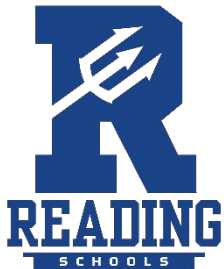
- SB 1 was signed into law by Gov. DeWine Oct. 29
- ODE may begin issuing temporary substitute licenses to individuals without a bachelor's degree
- Permits local Boards of Education to adopt policy permitting employment of individuals without a postsecondary degree as a substitute teacher
- SubSolutions (the COG) employs our substitute teachers and will be adopting policy to reflect these new requirements
- Language from SubSolutions will be provided when approved



RJSH Gaming Club

Summary:

- After school pilot club for students with interests in electronic or other gaming options
- Supervision and support by Mr. Little - RJSH Science teacher (Volunteer)
- Tuesday after school and every other Thursday
- Gaming systems provided or optional student consoles/devices
- Policy requirements for a new club:
 - Proposal
 - Principal approval
 - Superintendent approval
 - Board approval
- Action allows club to operate and fund code created for club finances/activities

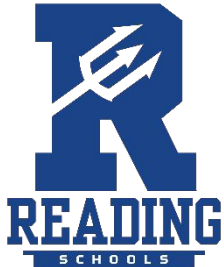
