#### **Hilltop Property - Athletic Field Progress**

- Bid Opening April 5 at 3:00
- Apparent low bid received includes:
  - Base bid
  - Alternate 1 Irrigation system
  - Alternate 2 Warning tracks
    - \*Alternate 3 Batting Cages on hold until final funding determined
- Bid verified and details (bonding, etc) determined
- Next step Project scope review meeting
  - Anticipate within two weeks in preparation for Board meeting April 21



#### **Central Property - Ongoing Analysis of Property Future**

- Security
  - Fencing approximately \$52,000 (4 ft vinyl)
  - Bollards/trees approximately \$100,000
  - Camera/video surveillance not yet determined
- Repair (existing damage)
  - Approximately \$10,000
- Maintenance
  - \$145 per mow
  - Awaiting quote for seed, weed control, and fertilizing applications
- Restroom Facility (portable)
  - \$115/month + delivery, tax, fuel surcharge, and winter salt (1 unit)



#### **PK-12 Campus - Property Line with Thurnridge**

- Thurnridge Resident Meeting 3/20
  - Property line concerns
    - Privacy/headlights impacting properties adjacent to RHS parking lot
    - Trees/vegetation along existing fenceline
      - Fence sits approximately 3 ft onto RCCSD property
      - Removing fence/trees/vegetation to construct fence would impact the natural barrier between properties
- PDD requires 6 foot fence installation

Solution: Install fence along a path that creates visual/headlight barrier near parking lot and between existing fence/light poles

\*\*Minor change to PDD; permit in progress with city; contingency funding will pay for installation
















#### PK-12 Campus - Chiller Noise on Thurnridge

- Sound study show chillers are operating within specifications
- Sound increases as a result of hard surfaces surrounding installed location
- Existing options/strategies have had no major impact on reducing chiller noise
- Manufacturer (Daikin) developed a sound blanket solution
  - Last, best option to decrease chiller noise for residents

Solution: Installation of product through Daikin; contract approved and work scheduled to begin week of April 19

#### **PK-12 Campus - Outdoor Classroom Sidewalk**

- Sidewalk installation needed for ADA compliance
- Architectural drawing and estimate received
- Approximately \$16,000 project

Solution: Completion of contract and scheduling installation
