COVID-19 Report

New ODH Guidance

- Released December 30, 2021
- Adopts new CDC recommendations

What's New - Confirmed Case:

- Isolate for 5 days from positive test
- If no fever and symptoms improved, return to school and wear a mask for an additional 5 days
- No requirement to test on day 5**

**CDC modified guidance on 1/4/22 - if access to a test, is fever free, recommend a rapid test, though still not a requirement



COVID-19 Report

K-12 Mask To Stay/Test To Play

- Continues and is modified with new guidance
- Applies to close contacts of a positive case *in a classroom environment*

Mask To Stay - *regardless of masking or vaccination status*

- may remain in school if wear a mask for 10 days, monitor for symptoms, and isolate/test if experience symptoms (start isolation protocol if positive)

Test To Play

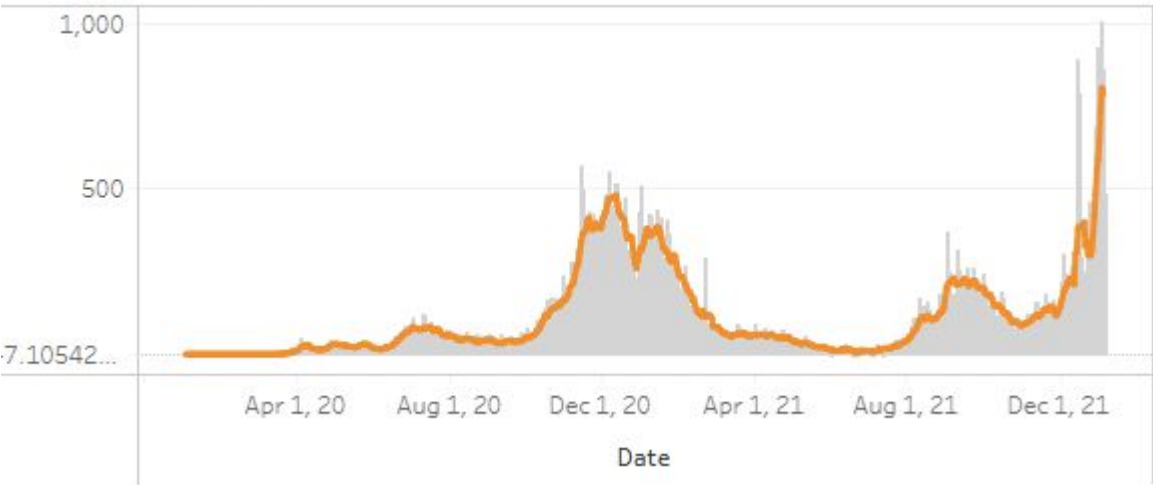
- asymptomatic may continue participating if:
 - wear a mask when possible
 - test on initial exposure*
 - test on day 5 is recommended*

~~*tests must be PCR or antigen and proctored/observed, may not be an over~~
the counter, at home test self-administered without a proctor



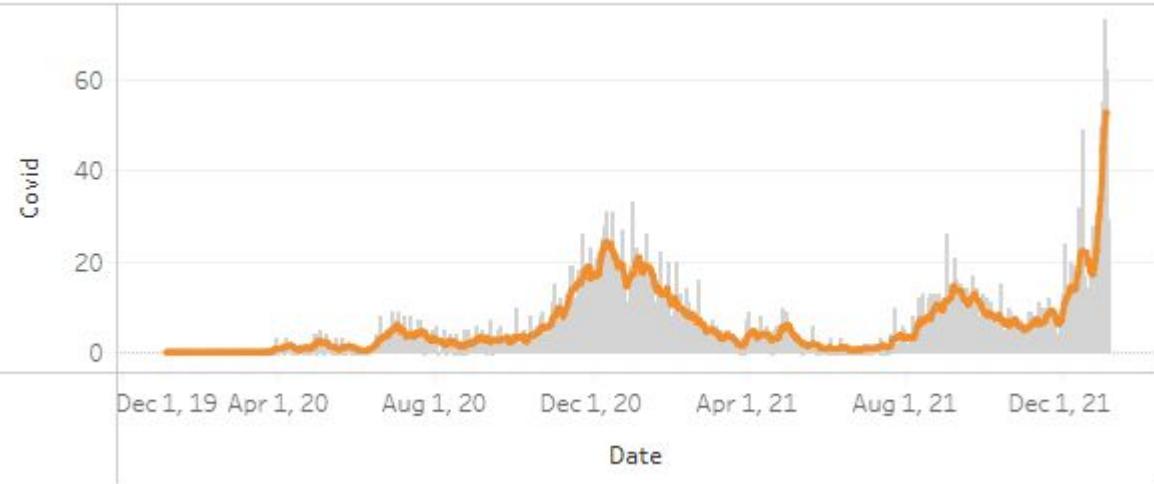

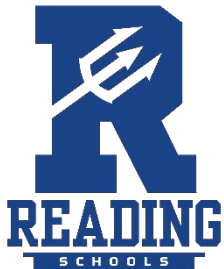
