BOARD DISCUSSION

Board Committees

Each committee lead gave their thoughts on purpose of committee and if there was a continued need for the committee to exist.

Building and Grounds Committee - Alycia Bemmes discussed the need for this to remain a board committee with some changes in the nature of the items they discuss. The committee will refine the goals of the committee. B&G will focus on the long term planning of district property and leave the maintenance related items to the Administration. The committee will oversee the leased properties as well. This committee will continue to oversee easements. The board was in agreement in keeping this as a board committee during reorganization.



City School Relations Committee - Crystal Menner discussed the overlap of City School Relations with the Buildings and Grounds Committee. She discussed the creation of the committee and its purpose was to better establish communication with the City. This goals have been achieved and did not see the necessity of keeping it as a board committee. Should the members of this committee be on the Building and Grounds committee to keep positive relationships with City personnel. The board agreed to no longer have the City School Relations Committee as a board committee in 2024 and if need arises to reestablish.

Finance Committee - Jim Perdue discussed the importance of the Finance Committee to provide fiscal transparency to the community on the financial matters. The committee has met in the past in May and November to discuss the presentation of the Five Year Forecast. Financial presentations are made at the Board meetings in May and November on the Five Year Forecast, on Federal funds in June and Permanent Appropriations in September. Further discussion was had regarding the frequency of the meetings. The board decided to have the committee to determine if more or less meetings are needed and other related topics they would like to discuss. The district also post financials on Ohio CheckBook as well as shares district financial presentations in the board updates.

Policy Committee - Beth Wernery and the board discussed the importance of the board to be involved in policy making process. The board decided to keep the policy committee as a board committee.
